

**NORTH CODORUS TOWNSHIP**  
**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**7-year review of Agricultural Security Area**

This announcement will hereby serve to notify the citizens of North Codorus Township, York County that the North Codorus Township Board of Supervisors will conduct a review of the Agricultural Security Area within North Codorus Township pursuant to the Agricultural Area Security Law, Act 43 of 1981.

The aforementioned ASA description is currently on file and available for public inspection at the North Codorus Township Municipal Office, 1986 Stoverstown Road, Spring Grove, PA between the hours of 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM.

Any affected Municipality and any landowners who own land which is within, adjacent to, or near the area proposed to be continued in the agricultural security area may propose changes to the agricultural security area within 30 days of the date this notice is published. Property owners wishing to “include” or “delete” their parcels from the ASA must follow the procedures outlined in Act 43. Such proposed changes must be submitted to the North Codorus Township Supervisors, the County and Township Planning Commissions, and the Township Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee at the North Codorus Township Municipal Office on or before March 31, 2010.

Upon expiration of the aforementioned 30-day period, the existing Agricultural Security Area and any proposed changes will be submitted to the North Codorus Township Planning Commission, the York County Planning Commission, and the North Codorus Township Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee for review and recommendation. Thereafter, a public hearing will be held by the Township Supervisors to consider the continuation/proposed modifications and recommendations of the Planning Commissions and the Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee.
